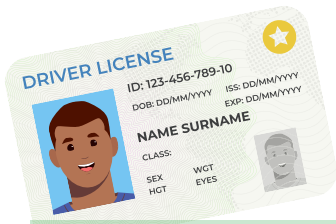

DRIVER'S PERMIT

Driver's permit is a special, provisional license that allows teenagers to begin learning how to drive legally in the USA before getting a full driver's license.

Key points

- Typically available to teenagers around the age of 16.
- Allow teenagers to drive with adult supervision.
- Its the first step towards obtaining a full drivers license.
- You need to complete a driver's education program.

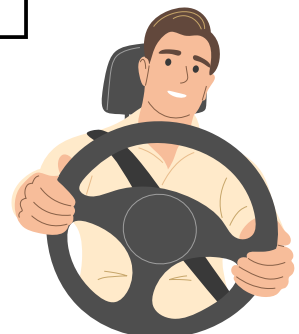

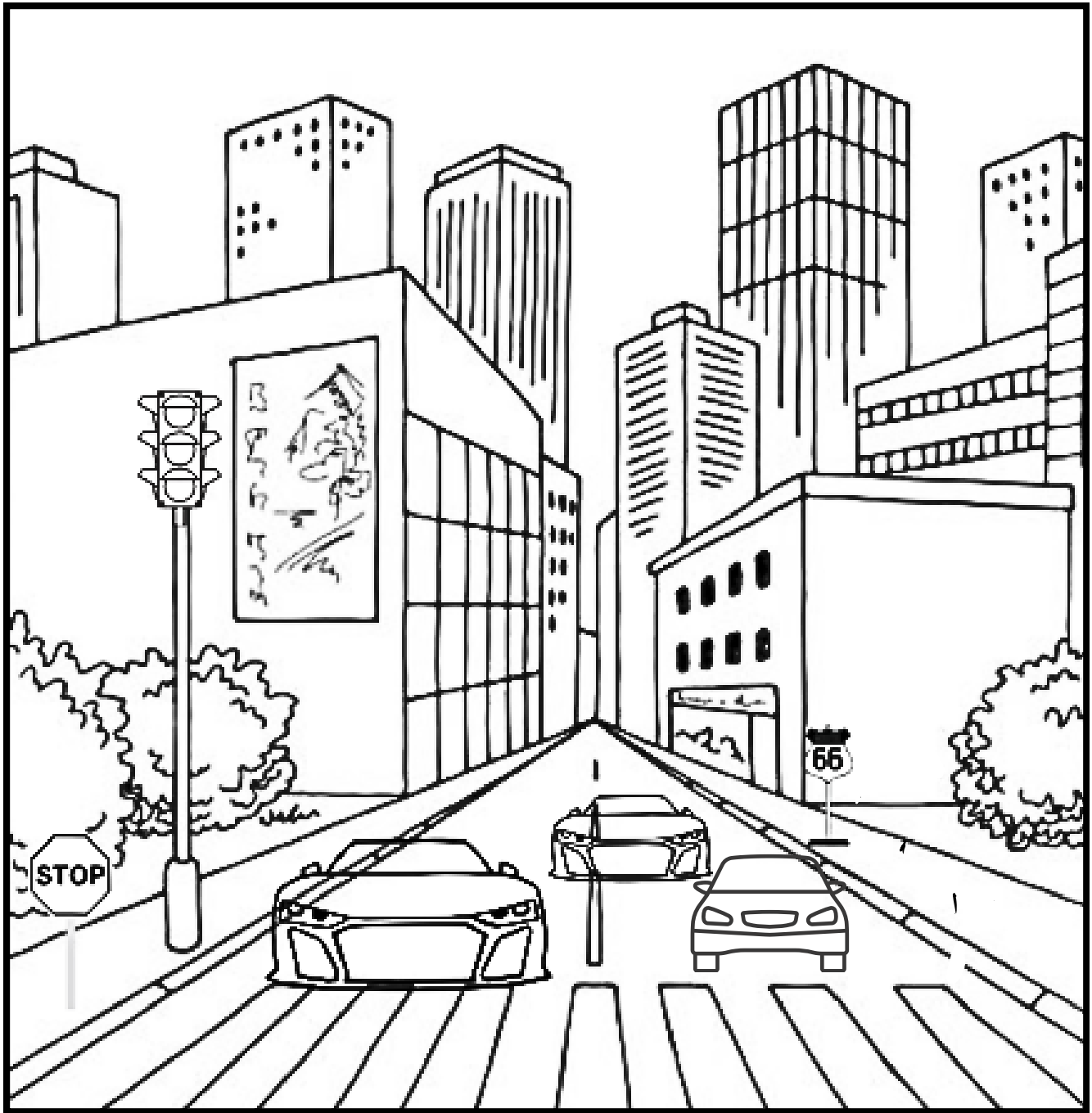

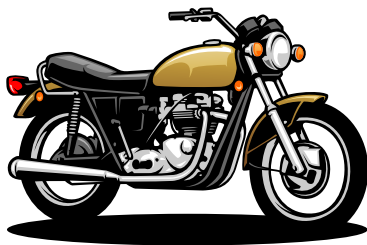
It's a small, lightweight vehicle with an electric motor.

Include a pedal-assist feature, where riders can use pedals to provide additional power, extending their range and offering exercise benefits

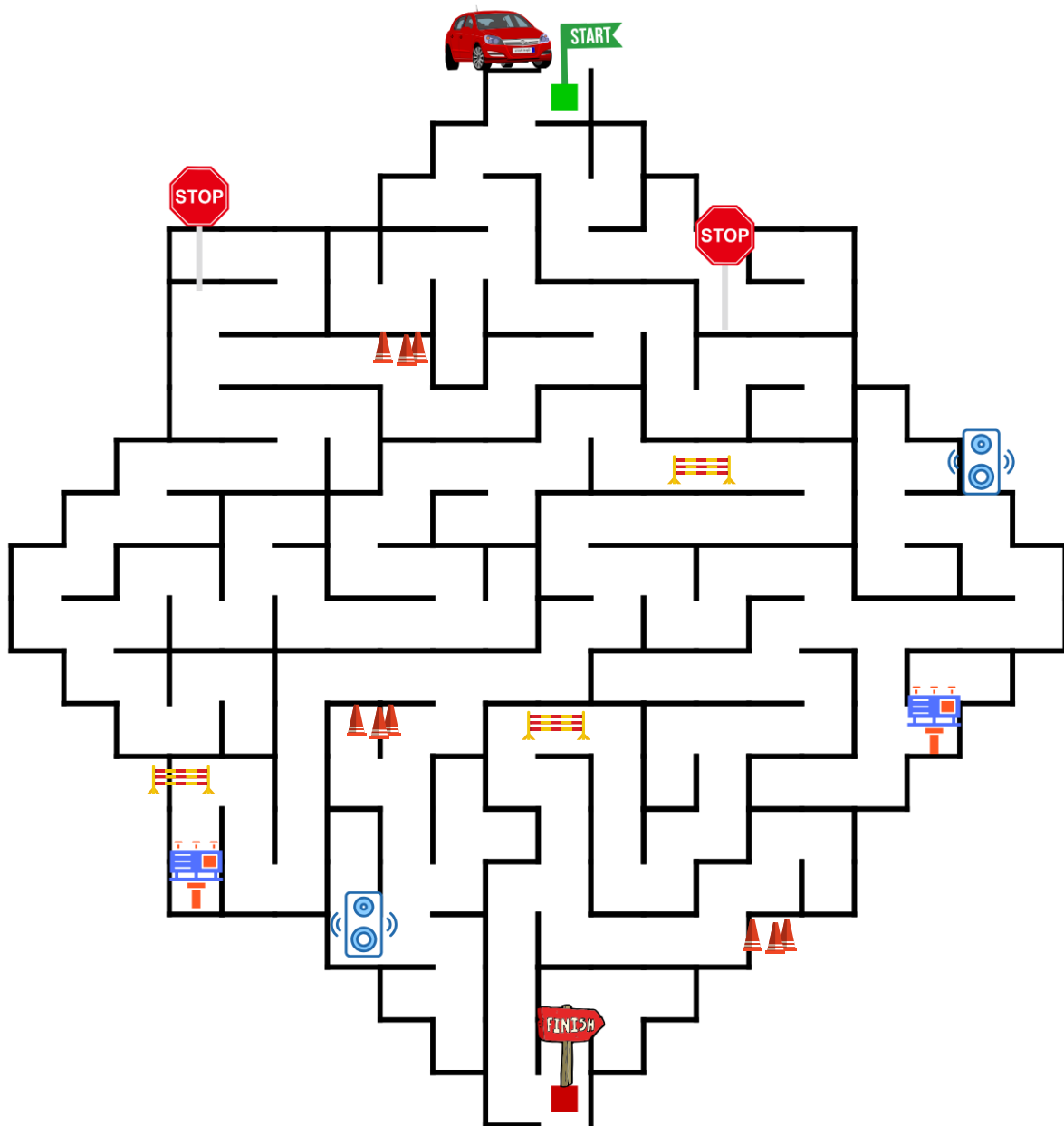


Produce zero emissions and are a sustainable and eco-friendly mode of transportation
