# ABOUT TEXT PLEDGE

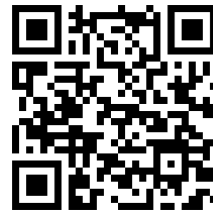

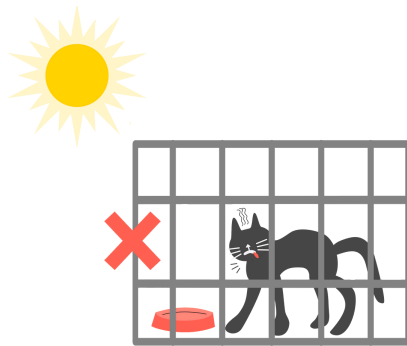


# WHAT ARE ANIMAL RIGHTS?
